Join The Baltimore Station as we celebrate our 23rd annual Homerun for Recovery fundraiser. The Baltimore Station is a therapeutic residential recovery program that helps homeless men – primarily veterans – bound by drug and alcohol addiction break the cycle and become self-sufficient members of society. The only long-term residential program in the area, The Baltimore Station provides up to 24 months of clinical care and life skills development to encourage a smoother transition to the real world and guaranteed lifelong success. The program serves 144 men at two locations - South Baltimore and Baker Street Station in West Baltimore.

OUR PROGRAM BENEFITS BALTIMORE

It costs The Baltimore Station just \$49 per day to provide food, housing and counseling services to a resident in our program. This amounts to less than half the cost of incarcerating a man for drug offenses in Maryland's prison system, not to mention the related addiction costs-hospital fees, police and judicial costs, and the consequences of drug-related crime across our city. When a man completes our program, he has learned that it was his actions, his choices and his lifestyle that led to his substance abuse and the consequences that follow. When they leave here, residents learn to adopt an entirely new way of looking at their lives, and are willing and able to take responsibility for themselves.
