Baltimore Station event sets record

The Baltimore Station, a residential treatment program supporting veterans and others transitioning from homelessness and substance use disorder to self-sufficiency, celebrated the 26th anniversary of its annual Homerun for Recovery fundraiser April 19 by raising more than \$170,000, the most raised in the event's history. More than 420 guests attended the event at PBR Baltimore in Power Plant Live. The event was presented by Columbia-based cybersecurity firm Fortego and sponsored by M&T Bank, Len the Plumber, Maryland Multi-Housing Association and Modu Tech among many other local businesses and individuals. The event's fundraising effort was driven by its signature live and silent auctions. Winning bidders went home with packages including vacations to Paris, Costa Rica and Chicago, tickets and a travel package to the Indianapolis 500 and luxury box accommodations and game-day privileges for a Baltimore Orioles game at Camden Yards, to name a few. Silent auction packages included brewery and wine tours, concert tickets, gift certificates from many of the city's finest restaurants and hotels, and collectors' items such as autographed sports memorabilia.
