BALTIMORE STATION'S HOMERUN FOR RECOVERY RAISES A RECORD \$172K

Baltimore Station celebrated the 27th anniversary of its annual Homerun for Recovery fundraiser by raising more than \$172,000, which broke last year's fundraising record and is the most raised in the event's history.
